## 16<sup>th</sup> East European Winter School

28<sup>th</sup> February – 14<sup>th</sup> March 2019

### I. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. The School is dedicated for students in their final year of the second degree humanities studies who are below the age of 25 (in special cases there can be an exemption), preparing master's theses (diploma) in the field of history or current affairs of Central and Eastern Europe (history, political science, international relations, sociology, philology, literature, cultural studies, ethnology, geography, law , economics). First degree students (Undergraduate bachelor students) cannot participate.
2. The application process is directed at participants from Central and Eastern Europe, the Baltics, the Balkans, Russia, Central Asia, the Caucasus, and Poland.
3. The level of Polish language knowledge should allow participants to understand lectures and process the information.

4. The School programme consists of lectures (the academic team is made up of renown international experts in the field) and seminars (choice of one seminar) during which each of the participant will refer a short presentation on the topic of their dissertation; the School will also be completed with study visits in various institutions in Warsaw and cultural programme.

## II. SCHOLARSHIPS

1. The candidates may apply for a scholarship covering the costs of the whole stay (or partial costs) during the school (accommodation in a hotel, catering, participation in lectures, seminars and associated events); and also for a covering a part of travel costs (does not apply to Polish student or student from the EU, or candidates currently studying in Poland or the EU countries).
2. The application for a scholarship should be submitted together with the School application.

## IV. QUALIFICATION PROCESS

1. The School's qualification committee will make decisions before the 1<sup>st</sup> February 2019 and immediately inform successful candidates.
2. The formal invitation for the participants of East European Winter School will be sent via email no later than on 5<sup>th</sup> February . The original invitation will be posted via traditional post, signed by the School's Director. Relevant Polish Consulates will be informed about the list of participants in order to facilitate formal processes to cross the Polish border.
3. Participants' arrival date: 27<sup>th</sup> February 2019. The School's inauguration is on 28<sup>th</sup> February 2019. Departure date: 15<sup>th</sup> March 2019.
